QUESTIONS SUBMITTED:

1. One location is listed and it says 20 meals are needed. Is that correct and who is currently serving your campuses?
 - a. The RFP states that the Gateway site has an average enrollment of 20 students, however it also states that there are 2 other sites serving special education students whose meals are to be delivered to the Gateway site. These sites are currently served by Revolution Foods.
2. Will we be responsible for delivering the meals?
 - a. The RFP states that meals for all sites are to be delivered to the Gateway campus.
3. How many meals per day?
 - a. Currently Gateway orders 17-20 breakfast and lunch meals a day; Special Education orders about 25, and the Early Childhood Education program (which will be expanding next year) orders under 5 meals a day.
4. Are there two meal services Breakfast and Lunch?
 - a. Currently Gateway is the only school that serves both meals.
