PAL ACTION ITEMS

PAL BOM Meeting: The BOM took no action on changing meeting times.

Flag Football for 2024: The BOM confirmed it will offer the sport in the fall of 2024.

Bylaw Article III Section 2: The BOM deleted the restriction for 17-year-olds playing JV football and added a bylaw that states "only freshmen may participate on freshman teams".

Approval of Fall 2024 Schedules: The BOM approved all schedules. In addition, it approved the new flag ball schedule and requested that girl's freshman volleyball be separated from the traditional league triple header schedule and a new schedule be made by the Commissioner to follow guidelines as agreed upon by the BOM.

CIF INFORMATION ITEMS

Air Quality Index Protocol, Emergency Action Plan/AED Protocol, and Heat Illness Protocol are Guidelines that the CIF will be putting in place soon.

CCS FIRST READING ITEMS

Football #1

Power Points denied for teams forfeiting games. BOM moved item to a second reading item and voted approval.

Football #2

Changes allowed for committee to adjust seeding for a significant misplacement. BOM moved item to a second reading item and voted approval.

Football #3

Predetermination of division placement based on league level of play. BOM moved item to a second reading item and voted approval.

Football #4

Allow leagues to determine allocation of CCS AQ's. BOM moved item to a second reading item and voted approval.

Girls Volleyball #1

Allow additional match for first round losers. BOM moved item to second reading item and voted disapproval.

CCS PLAY-OFF POLICY

New language for creation of play-offs for new sports. BOM moved item to second reading item and voted to approve.

CCS ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY POLICY

Adjusts the CCS eight semester bylaw to align with the new CIF bylaw. BOM moved item to a second reading item and voted to approve.

ARTICLE V START DATES

Proposal to move start date for football to the Monday of week #5. BOM sent this back to leagues to await the passing of the proposed CIF Acclimation Plan.

GENERAL BYLAWS
